AC	All items to be of contract quality suitable for commercial use.	02a
AC	Manufacturer to notify Purchasing Agent immediately if any items are not available. Partial shipments are acceptable with prior notification.	03
AC	Outside of all boxes must be sidemarked with Project Name, Area Name and Spec Number.	04
AC	All planters are to be sealed with a bituminous sealer or equivalent water repellent sealer to prevent leakage.	02
ART	Art to be vacuum mounted to 3/16" foam core. Corrugated cardboard is not acceptable.	
ART	All mats to be beveled. Mat to image.	
ART	Frames to be glued and nailed for stability.	
ART	Tape with moisture barrier tape applied to back of frame to protect against moisture intrusion.	
ART	Framing must be of contract quality, suitable for commercial use.	
ART	3 Security brackets to be installed onto each frame, 2 at top and 1 at bottom center. Hardware and instructions to be included.	
ART	Manufacturer to submit frame sample(s) for Designer approval prior to manufacturing.	04
ART	Manufacturer to tag backside of artwork with property, area name and spec number as specified.	03

BD	All drops/dimensions must be calculated from actual bedset/frame dimensions. Installer/Fabricator responsible for on-site correct measurements and yardages.	
BD	Manufacturer to sidemark outside of shipping box with property, item and area specified.	
BD	Dust Skirt: Manufacturer to provide 3" platform strips. Cotton/Polyester decking required.	
BD	Coverlet/Duvet: Foot corners to be rounded/squared.	
BD	All stitching to be double overlapped security stitching.	
BD	Fabricator to provide sample duvet/coverlet cover to Designer for approval prior to production for quantities of 20 or more.	
BD	All goods to be contract quality, suitable for commercial use.	
BD	Duvet Closure:	
BD	Manufacturer to pattern match at all seams. Pattern to be centered on width of bed. Stripes to run vertically (head to foot).	
BD	Manufacturer to line the dustskirt with ivory or cream sheeting that is treated with a topical flame retardant treatment. Manufacturer must submit a sample of the lining for Designer approval prior to manufacturing.
